In my first day of isolation, I can use some of the suggested resources on the **Day 1 in Isolation** from our school website

From day 2 in isolation, my teacher will be putting up daily lessons and activities for me to take part in. **Every day**, I should be doing the following:

1. Join my **LIVE class meet** each morning at 9:15am for 20 minutes
2. Watching my **grammar/writing** lesson (pre-recorded video by my teacher)
3. Watching my **maths** lesson (pre-recorded video by my teacher)
4. Completing the **reading assignment** that my teacher has put up
5. Completing the **topic** or **afternoon assignment** that my teacher has put up
