Provision for Children While Learning at Home

For all our Remote Learning elements, we would love for parents to help our children get set up with this support but every effort is being made by staff to free up parents as much as possible for their own working from home. Providing your child has access to paper and a pencil, please feel free to leave them to participate independently in the LIVE sessions.

<u>Phone Calls Home</u>

Teachers will make regular phone calls to stay in touch and check in with parents/children. Called ID may be blocked remember!

2x Core Subject Recorded Lessons

Teachers will upload 2x core lessons daily as a video for children to watch and try questions. Tasks are attached to submit for feedback from teacher.

Wider Curriculum Subjects

Teachers will upload a daily task for children to complete e.g. topic, science, RE, PSHE and submit.

LIVE Meet & Greet

All children will have a LIVE Meet & Greet (every morning for Years 1-6 and twice weekly for Reception) to see their friends and say hello. This is a chance for teachers to check in with pupils and take a register. It will lasts 10-15 mins.

LIVE Social Groups

Teachers or TAs will host a LIVE Meet for children to have an opportunity to see their friends socially and chat informally over Meet. This will typically occur weekly.

LIVE Small Group Academic Support

Teachers and TAs will timetable small group academic support groups to help your child's academic progress. These sessions will involve children working with an adult on an activity that has been planned for the day.

LIVE Drop In Sessions

These are for children in KS2. During these sessions, children have the opportunity to go through any challenging work/questions with their teacher or just share what they have produced. Your child's teacher will inform you via email of the timings of these sessions.
