Science	How do the changing seasons affect our local area?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Understand the changes that happen in autumn, winter, spring and summer. - Observe changes to our local area including trees in our playground across the seasons.
Geography	What are the Characteristics of England?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Identify where our school is and the surrounding area. - Understand that England is the country we live in, and identify where Bristol and London are on a map. - Identify human and physical geographical features in England.
Music	Instrumental - Glockenspiel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Identify the pulse of different pieces of music. - Understand that different notes have different sounds. - Learn how to make those different sounds on a glockenspiel along with music.
PSHE	Being Me	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Settle into year 1 together. - Come up with some ideas on how we can help make the classroom a safe and happy place for all.
