Understanding the World – Science Focus – Seasons	What are the different seasons?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Learn the four different seasons of the year - Discuss how we know what season it is and learn new vocabulary to understand the change in seasons
Understanding the World - History Focus– Past and Present	What is different between the past and present?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Compare items and objects from the past and present. - Discuss the differences seen through new vocabulary.
Understanding the World – RE Focus – Our World	What are we celebrating this term?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Learn about the celebrations and festivities taking place this term, including Harvest festival, Diwali, Guy Fawkes and Christmas, - Explore the purpose of the celebrations and broaden our vocabulary
Expressive Art and Design – Art Focus - Self Portraits	What do I look like?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Identify facial features using tools such as mirrors - Pick colours to match our features - Mark make to make a picture representing myself
