



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Topic	Big Question	Learning
Science – Light	How does light enable us to see everyday objects?	Recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines Use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye Explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes Use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them
History – Ancient Benin	Explain the rise and fall of Ancient Benin	Where was the kingdom of Ancient Benin and what time period were they around? How did the kingdom of Benin expand and become wealthy? (location/ trade and leaders) Why did the Kingdom of Benin end?
Art – 2D Drawing to 3D Making	How can I turn 2D drawing to 3D making?	Explore the relationship between 2d and 3d. Explore challenges faced by working in 3 dimensions. Explore drawing and mark making skills and seen how they transfer to different disciplines and genres.
French – À l'école (At School)	What did you learn at school?	Learners look at how the internet facilitates online communication and collaboration; they complete shared projects online and evaluate different methods of communication
PSHE – Being me	Being me in my world	Identify goals for the year There are universal rights for children but sometimes these are not met My actions affect other people locally and globally
Music	History of Music - Pop	Learners look at the history of pop music. Learners critique and analyse artists from the past. Learners create their own piece in a similar style.
PE	Athletics	Children to apply their knowledge, understanding and skills into a series of competitions. Children will experience competition across all of the different areas of athletics that they have explored. Pupils will have to work hard individually to apply the correct technique as well as collaborating in teams.
