Science – Materials	Can changes be reversed?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Identify evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature.</li> <li>- Know that some materials will dissolve in liquid to form a solution and describe how to recover a substance from a solution.</li> <li>- Use knowledge of solids, liquids, and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaporating.</li> </ul>
