EYFS

Within EYFS, teachers use Early Learning goals to monitor pupils' knowledge of the world around them. These goals are overarching themes for the year but examples are shown for activities that may support assessment of these.

Past and Present:

- Talk about the lives of the people around them and their roles in society
- Know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now, drawing on their experiences and what has been read in class
- Understand the past through, setting, characters, and events encountered in books read in class and story telling

Example of application: To evidence these goals teachers will talk to children about what happened yesterday or last week, provide opportunities to explore after the event e.g Christmas in January, discuss photos and videos, relate time to experiences in school and preschool, and develop a sense of time.
